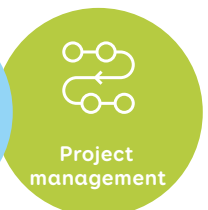
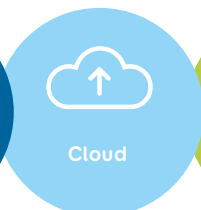
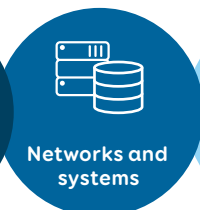




INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY VET INTERNATIONAL
